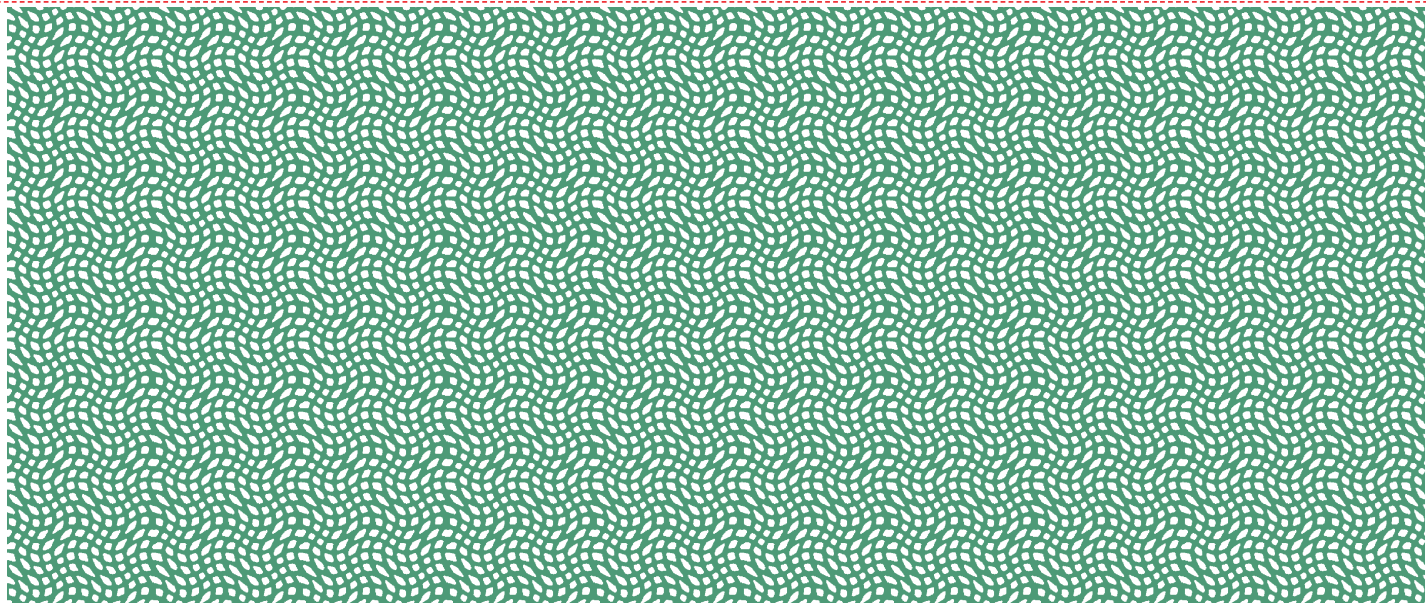

Heat sensitive pink flag disappears when exposed to heat, by rubbing or touching with thumb.

 The security features listed below, as well as those not listed, exceed industry guidelines.

**Security Features**

**Description**

- Colored Background
- Microprinting 
- Artificial Watermark
- Faces of check has a colored background.
- Small type appears as dotted line when photocopied.
- Invisible watermark on back of check will appear when rubbed with a coin, under ultraviolet light or hold at an angle to view.
- Warning band at top of check lists security features.

 Padlock design is a certification mark of Check Payment Systems Association 

- Pink flag on back of check should disappear when rubbed with thumb or finger.
- When chemically altered, the area treated will appear as a brown stain or spot.
- Visible only under ultraviolet light.

- Cannot be photocopied or scanned.
